In this column back in 2008 I explained the state requirement to combine small schools with larger ones. If a merger did not take place, a penalty would be assessed of millions of dollars. Thinking this would actually happen, OOB taxpayers voted to join the City of Saco and the Town of Dayton to become a Regional School Unit (RSU). The whole idea was to help save money with mostly administrative positions and utilities. As of July 1, 2009, the 3 school districts became RSU#23. The other school districts that voted not to join in RSU's never got fined.

As of July 1, 2014, OOB will be the only school system left in RSU#23 as both Dayton and Saco voted to withdraw. OOB is presently in the process of hiring administration positions and has elected to join with Biddeford schools to share a position to oversee the food service. Being an RSU means the taxpayers of OOB hold a "town meeting" style meeting to vote on the 11 articles for the school board budget. After passing the budget, it has to go to vote on an Election Day ballot.

In other news, I have an update on where the Association is in terms of becoming non-profit and tax exempt. Papers were filed with the state and we are officially non-profit incorporated as of May 13, 2014. Kenney Fletcher '78, CPA, has filed for tax exempt status from the state and we are waiting for the results.
