Sharri has served the town in so many ways it is difficult to quantify how much she gives back to our community. She is a tireless advocate for the Beach, the Town, and our schools. A dedicated resident, she has honorably served on the School Board, the Town Council, and has even represented us in Augusta as a member of the House of Representatives in the State Legislature. Whether organizing a food drive for the local food pantries, creating an entire database for the Rotary Auction, or designing AMAZING graphics/posters for so many different entities (including the Alumni Association, Rotary, the Ballpark, and various teams that have played there) she is constantly engaged and involved in the community, regardless of her position, and is a true community leader. 
