He died saving a fellow firefighter, shielding him with his own body, sacrificing his own life. Capt. Joel Barnes, Class of 2005, was inducted into the OOBHS Hall of Fame for his bravery and ultimate contributions to society at The All-School Reunion in September 2019. Last spring, upon his death, family friend Sarah Place Mills '98 and her mom Cindy Rogers Mattson '76 approached the Alumni Association asking about starting a scholarship in Joel's name. It was immediately put in the newsletter, press releases sent out, and TV stations took to the air and teamwork made the dream work. Over \$10,000 has been raised in the past few months and an annual scholarship will be forever given to a graduate entering the Firefighter, Emergency Medical Technician or Public Safety field starting in June 2020 and graduating from Old Orchard Beach High School.

The Alumni Association inducted Capt. Barnes after a moving video about the tragic events while sharing his life, family, and legacy to all in attendance. Fellow Alumni, firefighters, family, and friends witnessed a tribute to Joel while a Firefighter's boot amd helmet were open for monetary donations towards the Scholarship in Joel's name. The Alumni Association will send you a copy of the video on DVD for a donation of \$10 (including shipping) with 100% of the proceeds going to the scholarship fund in Capt. Joel Barne's name. 
