2nd OPERATION SEAGULL PRIDE SAVING A WYLAND MASTERPIECE CLOSE TO HOME

23 years ago in November 1999, the theme "Operation Seagull Pride' was used to establish the OOB Alumni Association. We are taking that theme out of the "mothballs' to face another major restoration of the Wyland mural project.

On October 1, 1998, the famous artist Wyland painted a mural on the outside of the John Regan Gymnasium. Mr. Wyland came back some years later and did a touch up job. He is not able to do that now but we have permission to do so. The mural faces the sun and has faded over the years. So to show our "Seagull Pride", the alumni has taken on this project along with the RSU#23 School Dept (formerly OOB Schools). We need your "Seagull Pride" again to restore the Wyland mural. Please see the fundraiser page and send in your chance(s) by June 1, 2021. Sandy does need advice and help from artists and contractors as to possible amounts of paint, supplies needed, type of equipment to use like lifts, etc. to complete the project. The mural will be restored when it is safe to do so. No date has been chosen at this time and more information will be available later. <u>Research Shows</u>: "1998 Wyland U.S. Migration 50 states in 50 days" selected the Town of Old Orchard Beach & OOBHS as his 25th painting. On Oct. 1st Wyland and his crew arrived with the theme of 'Linking Kids, Teachers, and Parents Around the World with Science and Art equalling Public Awareness to Save our Oceans." The mural was Dedicated in memory of John Denver 1943-1947. Alumnus Rusty Whitten helped finish the project due to Wyland's time schedule. The workers loved the lobster rolls served by Sandy in Home Ec.

The senior section of the yearbook is the first thing that has to be in to the printer by October 31 so some pictures are there and a person might not complete their senior year. The Association has been unable to have any of our usual fund-raisers (dances, Savor the Flavor, basketball games etc.) so we are trying to gain some extra money to cover expenses to take on the project of the Wyland mural (see pages 1 and 3) and printing of the newsletter. We are hoping that members will take part in the 2nd Operation Seagull Pride fundraiser. I hope this finds you safe and well so we will be able to get together soon.


