## Herbert Bean 2025 Hall of Fame Recipient

#### Long time OOBHS Principal to be enshrined posthumously



Herbert R. Bean was born in Brooklyn, New York on February 5, 1898, the son of Herbert I. and Maude (Crosse) Bean and died at the age of 73 on June 21, 1971 unexpectedly in the afternoon at his summer home on Swan Pond, Lyman. At the time of his death, Mr. Bean was a retired Old Orchard Beach High School principal and former commander of the Department of Maine American Legion.

Mr. Bean was a graduate of Bates College in Lewiston, Maine and had been active in Bates alumni affairs. He did his graduate work at Yale University in New Haven, Connecticut. Herbert Bean had served as principal at Old Orchard Beach High School for 28 years before retiring in 1963. Mr. Bean was a strong supporter of youth and over the years had been keenly interested in school athletic events. He was a decorated veteran of the First World War serving with the 103rd Infantry, Yankee Division in France.

From the time of World War II, he had served with and had chaired the York County Selective Service Board in Kennebunk. Locally, Mr. Bean was a past president and active member of the Kiwanis Club, trustee and former chairman of the school district, director of The Webber Hospital in Biddeford and a member of Washington Avenue Methodist Church in OOB. Mr. Bean had been active in the Biddeford-Saco Lodge of Elks & was a member of the Lewiston Masonic bodies.

Mr. Bean was married to Naomi Smith Bean of Old Orchard Beach and had 3 sons, the late Franklin G. of Rumford, the late David of Tewksbury, MA., Jonathan of Clearfield, UT., and 3 daughters, the late Valerie Bean Chapman of Gardiner, ME., the late Alice Bean Dale and Constance Bean of Old Orchard Beach as well as 15 grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Congratulations Mr. Bean and thank you for your services as we remember you in The OOBHS Hall of Fame.

Dear RSU 23 Community,

I'd like to introduce <u>The Seagull Foundation</u>. The Seagull Foundation's mission is to enhance the experience of students in Old Orchard Beach Schools by expanding opportunities beyond those provided through public funding. The Seagull Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization created to allow individuals and corporations with a means to provide tax-deductible financial and in-kind support to the Old Orchard Beach Schools.

We will begin our fundraising journey accepting donations to construct a new concession stand and press box for Joe Regina field. In the past few years we have replaced the track, scoreboards, and fencing around the facility. The last phase of the project is the concession building. Our fundraising goal is \$150,000. The fundraising campaign will end on March 31, 2026. Individuals and businesses who donate \$5,000 or more will have their name prominently featured on the west side of the building for the entire life of the structure. Construction will begin in the spring of 2026 with a completion date and dedication in August 2026.

After this capital project is completed, individuals, businesses, alumni, and members of the public will be able to donate to the foundation in the area of their choice. This could include a general donation or a targeted donation (a school, curriculum, music department, theatre, etc.). Our goal is to have the Seagull Foundation become a long-lasting resource for charitable giving for those who love and support our schools in RSU 23 Old Orchard Beach. 
