



Charlie Shuman '64 Hall of Fame Inductee

Reunion 2022 features Charlie Shuman, Class of 64 and owner of Charlie's Family of Dealerships in Augusta, with his induction into the Alumni Hall of Fame. Charlie was born in Boston and moved with his family to Old Orchard Beach at age 11. He was one of six children. After graduation Charlie earned a Bachelor's degree in technology and business in 1979 at U. S. M. after attending night school in Portland over 15 years. It is that same determination and hard work that propelled him in his career, first at Henley Kimball Co., a Portland dealer, where he rose to parts manager, and then to American Motors Corp. becoming a district parts and service manager for all of Maine, New Hampshire, and sections of Massachusetts.

In 1986 Charlie partenered with a dealer he knew to open a Subaru store in Augusta. He and his wife, Nancy, scraped up every dime they could for the business and within 5 years bought out his partner. He has grown the business from a single franchise Subaru dealership to today's 8 franchises and 9 buildings while going from 17 employees to over 280.

Charlie explained, "We have always been successful, highly profitable, and able to give back to the community that made me so successful." He estimates he has donated more than \$3 million to local charities and organizations including the United Way, Augusta Food Bank, Kennebec United Way, Winthrop Food Pantry, Avian Have Wild Bird Rehab Center in Freedom, ME., American Lung Association's Trek Across Maine, Maine Breast Cancer Coalition, as well as numerous other charities. He also sponsors events to benefit a local no-kill cat shelter and youth scholarships.

The most meaningful civic achievement is his work with the United Way. Charlie said, "Every year I help to attain their hefty goal of raising \$1.5 million. The money raised helps support 43 local agencies that aid children, single parents, abused women, the elderly, the homeless, and anyone who needs shelter, heat, food and counseling."

Charlie has also made contributions to construction and healthcare initiatives at Thomas College in Waterville, Maine General's Harold Alfond Center for Cancer Care in Augusta and Temple Beth El in Augusta where The Nancy and Charlie Shuman Center for Jewish Learning is named to honor him and his wife.

A member of the Board of Directors of the Kennebec Chamber of Commerce since 1987, Charlie generously donates his time and talent for the betterment of the community. He has received many distinguised awards for his efforts but is most proud of receiving the 2014 Kennebec Valley Chamber of Commerce Special Service Award and the 2015 Maine Jewish Museum's Lifetime Achievement Award. "These honors were given to me for the work that I have done to support local and state communities both monetarily and through my leadership abilities," he said. "They also solidify my commitment to ethical business practices and local economies.

He and his wife, Nancy, have 2 children and 6 grandchildren. He is proud that his son, Stephen, and daughter Elissa, now hold key leadership positions and are driving the next generation's growth.

This month we congratulate Dana Kelley (**Class of 69**) on his retirement from The OOB Police Dept. after almost 50 years of service to the community. Dana started his career with the OOBPD in 1973, promoted to corporal in 1976, sargeant in 1977, and captain in 1987. He was also a detective 1978-1980 before becoming the

acting police chief in 1989 before assuming the role as full time chief the last 20 years. He has developed the department's reserve program, Community Watch Council, and The Volunteers in Police Service Program. Chief Kelley is a graduate of the 172nd session of the FBI National Academy Program. Dana was instrumental in the construction of the department's new facility and the mobile parking meter program was implemented under his direction. Town Manager Diana Asanza was quoted as saying "Chief Kelley has dedicated himself to serving the community, and Old Orchard Beach is better for it."


